Enroll in the Central Background Registry (CBR): Child care employees must pass a fingerprint-based background check. Pediatric First Aid and CPR: Employees must have current Pediatric CPR/First Aid certification.  If a CPR class is not available before your start date AND your employer agrees, you may begin work without CPR, but you must complete it within 90 days of your start date.
